**WHEREAS** 

the National Dental Care Day Foundation is a volunteer-led initiative that has, for over a decade, provided free dental services across Ontario, and now seeks to expand into a unified, coast-to-coast movement dedicated to restoring dignity through smiles;

National Dental Care Day, observed on October 10, brings together dental professionals from across Canada who commit to one day of service annually, offering a free dental procedure—cleaning, filling, or extraction—to individuals in need, regardless of insurance or income status;

participating clinics will also provide oral health education, community outreach, and volunteer engagement activities, fostering compassion, awareness, and preventative care within local communities;

this initiative promotes the importance of oral health, helps reduce barriers to essential dental care, and reflects the City of Thompson's commitment to health equity, dignity, and volunteerism:
